QUESTION!

Is my child required to take part in all activities at camp?

ANSWER:

No camper is required to take part in any activity, however we take pride in offering the opportunity for EVERY child to TRY each activity. You never know when a new passion will develop.

QUESTION!

What happens if my camper is injured or feels unwell at camp?

ANSWER:

Your child will be taken to our First Aid building. Our Red Cross Certified (First Aid & C.P.R.) Staff Member will help all campers. Parents & Emergency #s will be called right away.

QUESTION!

What Happens on RAINY DAYS?

ANSWER:

Rainy days at camp are FUN too! We have 2 large air conditioned indoor buildings as well as our large pavillion & Ampitheater.

QUESTION!

How will you keep my camper safe from germs & lice when using a helmet at camp?

ANSWER:

Single Use medical grade hair nets (specifically designed to be used with helmets) will be used under every helmet at camp. We sterilize helmets daily.

QUESTION!

Can my camper bring a cell phone to camp?

ANSWER:

We have a camp phone that is available for use at any time. Individual camper phones & other electronics **MUST** be left at home.

QUESTION!

What happens if my child doesn't know how to swim?

ANSWER:

Great Question! We raised the bottom of our pool to 2 1/2 feet in the shallow end and 5 feet in the "deep end" for additional safety. Non-swimmers will be limited to the shallow end. We will be assessing our campers for swim skills on the very first day of camp. Our lessons will take place during our group Swim Instruction. We have 2 lifeguards in chairs as well as the pool manager. Additionally, our Counselors will be in the pool with our campers.

QUESTION!

Will I get a refund if my camper's plans change for the summer?

ANSWER:

The answer is always YES. Of course, we prefer some advance notice to allow for other campers to take their place, but we understand that life happens
